
The CarePoint and Graduation

A CarePoint is where the community's most vulnerable children and community members can receive critical resources that empower them to live dignified and self-sustaining lives.

CarePoint graduation means:

- CHC withdrawing from direct implementation in a community
- Handing over operations to a Community-Based Organization.
- A time when our interventions have yielded positive outcomes in the community and have empowered and "readied" them for self-reliance and sustainability.

- Capacity Building of the PMC members and guardians
- Encouraging children to commit to stay at school and achieve a successful outcome.



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- Complacency over time by beneficiaries
- The future of children and youth still in school may be forced to drop out if a strong financing and monitoring strategy is not put in place to support them
- Funding for the continuity of CBO projects may be fluid because of stiff funding opportunities
